It was a miracle that they were not both killed as the force of the explosion hurled pieces of iron over 300 feet away, and the sound of the explosion could be heard several blocks away.

1000 Sheep Shot

Baker City, July 25.—Report reached here yesterday that 1000 head of sheep the property of Lux & Miller of San Francisco, were shot in the Granite mining district of eastern Grant county yesterday. The band was being taken to Wyoming for summer range. Sheep owners had been warned to keep off certain mining property because of damage to the water supply and to the forage the miners wanted for their horses. The herdsmen persisted and the miners destroyed a large part of the band. Only slight details have been received.

Three years ago she was united in marriage to Mr. Herbert E. Bachus and they have lived at Perry since that time. She was a good Christian woman and made friends of all those who met her. She leaves behind a child only a few days old, and also a husband, father, and mother, two sisters, Mrs. Fred Robertson and Mrs. Phil Thompson, of Perry, and two brothers to mourn her loss.

Arabian Rebellion

Hodjedo, Yemen Province, Turkish Arabia, July 25.—The Turks are meeting with some success against the insurgents at Sanna, the capital city of Yemen province. Operations to recover possession of that city commenced July 17 from three directions. Marshall Ahmed Fez Pasha, at the head of the Albanian battalions, dislodged the rebels from a strong position near Menakha, inflicting several losses on them.

Notice To Water Consumers

All persons knowing themselves to be in arrears for city water are hereby notified to call at the office of the city Recorder and settle at once. In order that there may be no mis understanding we cite the customer to the following section of the city ordinance. This ordinance will be in force.

Section 28.—The water rates shall be payable in advance at the office of the water superintendent on the first day of each month (except for meters which are payable on the first day of the succeeding month), and if not paid within the first ten days the water will be shut off the premises, as provided in Sections 26 and 27.

Later ordinance provides that water rates shall be payable to City Recorder instead of Water Superintendent.
