DUTCH SUBDUCE CELEBES REBELS

Singapore India July 31st.—The Dutch expedition sent against the Prince Boni in the island of Celebes, Malay Archipelago, were successful. On July 28th seven warships bombarded Badju, the capital, and later landed troops. A fierce land fight followed, the rebels leaving two hundred and fifty six dead, while the Dutch lost three killed and twenty six wounded.

Government Finances

Washington July 31.—The monthly statement of the government receipts and expenditures which will be issued by the treasury department on August 1st will show the receipts for July, 1905, to have been approximately \$49,180,000 and the expenditures about \$52,980,000, leaving a deficit for the month of \$3,800,000. The deficit last month was \$17,800,000.

There were no extraordinary receipts of expenditures in July, 1904, and none will appear in the figures for the present month. This decrease of about \$3,600,000 in the deficit for the month as compared with that for July 1904, is accounted for by the material increase in the receipts, particularly from customs, and a slight decrease in expenditures. The returns from customs alone will exceed those for July last year by about \$2,000,000. These from internal revenue sources will probably exceed those of a year ago by about \$200,000. The receipts this month will include a payment of about \$3,000,000 from the Southern Pacific railway company on account of its thirteenth semi-annual note due the government August 1st. There was a similar payment from this company last July. The treasury officials regard the showing this month with satisfaction and point to the \$2,000,000 increase in business during the remainder of the year.

Russian Strike Spreads

Warsaw Poland Russia July 31.—Ten thousand workmen are idle on account of the strike movement spreading here. Daily conflicts are frequent with the troops. Two of the large iron works have closed.

Portland Attorney Dead

Portland, July 30.—Ex-Judge Dell Stuart, a prominent attorney of Portland, member of the Masons, Knights of Pythias and other orders, ex district judge of Iowa, and ex-mayor of Osceola, Ia., died today at St. Vincent's hospital as the result of an operation. The death of Judge Stuart was sudden and unexpected. He was operated upon 11 days ago and seemed on the road to recovery. Judge Stuart was born in Zanesville, O., in 1849.

Thief Confesses

Seattle, July 31.—Lester Richardson, 19 years old, son of respectable parents, who is under arrest for burglary, yesterday confessed that in the last two months he has looted 20 rooms in various hotels in the city, securing money and jewelry which he lavished on his friends. From one room Richardson stole \$520 that he spent in two weeks.

Conductor J C Gulling who was a delegate to the National Grande Lodge of Elks, which met at Buffalo, returned home Sunday morning. Mr Gulling returned by way of Portland where he stopped off a few days to visit the exposition.

Notice To Water Consumers

All persons knowing themselves to be in arrears for city water are hereby notified to call at the office of the city Recorder and settle at once. In order that there may be no miss under standing we cite the customer to the following section of the city ordinance. This ordinance will be in force.

Section 28.—The water rates shall be payable in advance at the office of the water superintendent on the first day of each month (except for meters which are payable on the first day of the succeeding month), and if not paid within the first ten days the water will be shut off the premises, as provided in Sections 26 and 27.

Later ordinance provides that water rates shall be payable to City Recorder instead of Water Superintendent.
