## Preacher Convicted

Valdosta, Ga., August 1—Rev J G Rawlins early yesterday was found guilty of accessory to the murder of two children of Rev and Mrs W L Carter, and unless a higher court intervenes Rev Rawlins and his sons, Jesse and Milton, and Alf Moore, a negro, will have to hang. The Rawlins sons and Moore were found guilty of the murder some time ago.

Both Rawlins and Carter were for years ministers in the Methodist church. A feud started and Rawlins plotted to wipe out the Carter family. It was arranged that Moore and Milton, Jesse and Leonard Rawlins, were to go to the Carter home and kill the parents while they sat at the supper table. When the children ran out they were to be shot down.

The assassins, however, arrived after the evening meal, and could not shoot through the windows at their victims. Some noise caused Willis and Belle Carter to run out into the yard. Instantly the guns of the murderers spoke and the girl fell dead. The boy, shot through the body, dragged himself into the house and told who had done the thing.

All night long Rev and Mrs Carter crouched in their home. Through the crevices in the loghouse the Carters could see the assassins creeping about the yard, but whether their daughter was dead or not they could not learn.

Finally Rev Carter reached his rifle and fired through a crack in the door. The shot caused the murderers to flee. Moore confessed the plot.

## "Hello" On Telegraph

Los Angeles Cal August 1—Telegraphones, the new instruments which make it possible to use telegraph wires for communication by telephone have been supplied to all passenger crews of the Los Angeles division of the Southern Pacific, and the railroad company is now prepared to give the invention the first practical test in California.

By means of the telegraph employes on trains may be placed in direct communication with the dispatcher at the end of the division within two minutes after the train has been brought to a stop. The instrument is hung to the side walls of one of the cars and the connecting wires are brought in contact with the telegraph wire by an extension rod.

Should officials of this division find the invention to come up to their expectations, it is the ultimate intention of the Southern Pacific management to similarly equip the entire system.

## Scrub Stock Fight

Salem Aug 1—Golden J Exile, supposedly a bull of high grade, took prizes at the live stock show at Salem Walla Walla and North Yakima, and was sold by the owner, Dave Looney, for a fancy price. Looney also owned what was known as the Miller bull, and Miss Lou Miller has identified Golden J Exile as the latter. The animal was bred by her father and she had tattooed the letters "G. M." in its ear with India ink.

Complaint was made to the American Jersey Cattle club, and W M Ladd of Portland made an investigation. Looney says that his foreman reported the Miller bull dead when it was probably the high grade animal which died. The outcome of the trial before the American Jersey club is being watched with interest, for upon the verdict rests Looney's reputation as a breeder.

## Sets New Record

Cape May, N J Aug 1—Being officially timed today by Sam Butler, secretary of the Automobile Club of America Walter Christie, in his 120 horse power automobile reduced the American kilometer record by making the distance in 25 seconds flat.

He made several attempts but could not reduce his own time farther today his best later time being 25 1/2 seconds. He will try again for the world's kilometer and mile records on August 19.
