Contest of the Zeigler Will is Won by Widow

New York, Aug. 3.—By a payment of \$2,500,000 to the widow of the late William Zeigler, the Zeigler will contest was settled yesterday. Justice Giegrich, in the supreme court signed an order authorizing Justice Gaynor, executor of the estate, to pay \$5 Matilda Zeigler \$1,200,000 in cash and 5000 shares of Royal Baking Powder company stock valued at \$1,300,000. William Zeigler, the 14 year old son of the testator, consented to this settlement which is a release of all of Mrs. Zeigler's rights and dower and other claims against the estate of William Zeigler. The will, the validity of which this suit was a test, left Mrs. Zeigler the use of the city and country houses of her husband and an income of \$50,000 a year. The remainder of the estate was given to the adopted son. Mr. Zeigler left real estate valued at \$4,000,000 and personal property estimated at \$14,000,000 in New York state and also about \$200,000 in the state of New Jersey and Connecticut. Under the contested will the value of the estate left to the adopted son amounted to about \$18,000,000.

Mount Rainer is Now Considered Highest

Portland Ore August 3.—Barometrical measurements made by A G McAdie of the weather bureau, San Francisco office, and Professor Leconte of the University of California, of Mount Rainer show that mountain to be 14,530 feet above sea level, and Mount Whitney in California, heretofore registered as the highest American mountain on this side of Alaska, only 14,515 feet, proving the Washington peak to be fully 15 feet higher. Measurements of both mountains were taken with the same barometers. As leaders in the recent mountain climbing expeditions of the Sierras, Mazamas and Appalachia clubs, the two men have collected a great deal of valuable scientific data on subjects long in dispute.

Three are Killed in Riot

San Juan, P R Aug 3.—As the result of the longshoremen's strike for an increase in wages, which has been in progress for a month, the greater portion of San Juan was under control of a mob last night. The mob numbering over 1000 armed persons rushed through the streets fighting the police who fired upon the assailants wounding over 40. All the electric light globes were destroyed and the city was in darkness all night. This morning the police, finally got control, but further trouble is anticipated and reinforcements have been asked for. The casualty list is three killed and 45 injured, of which several will die.

Notice To Water Consumers

All persons knowing themselves to be in arrears for city water are hereby notified to call at the office of the city Recorder and settle at once. In order that there may be no miss understanding we cite the customer to the following section of the city ordinance. This ordinance will be enforced.

Section 28.—The water rates shall be payable in advance at the office of the water superintendent on the first day of each month (except for meters which are payable on the first day of the succeeding month), and if not paid within the first ten days the water will be shut off the premises, as provided in Sections 26 and 27.

Later ordinance provides that water rates shall be payable to City Recorder instead of Water Superintendent.
