Electric Lights For Union

The Grande Ronde Electric Company have placed the order for the necessary equipment to furnish light and power to Union. Work is expected to commence within ten days and the system completed within the next 90 days. When Union is connected, this will make Cove, Hot Lake, Island City, La Grande and Union all receiving light and power from this one company. Ten years ago, who would have thought of little Cove creek moving the wheels nearly all over the valley. Within sixty days however, the Morgan Lake power will come to the rescue with an additional 800 horse power, and when this is exhausted the Minam will be called upon with unlimited power to meet future demands.

J W Cook In City

J W Cook, president and manager of the Wallowa Valley Railway company, was in the city last evening having come up on the Big Six train and returned this morning on the same train, being in the city on business connected with his proposed line. Mr Cook feels confident that his suit with the O. R. & N. for right of way title will result in a victory for him when they come to trial and that his road cannot help but go through to Joseph as proposed. No date has yet been set for the hearing but will undoubtedly come up before the courts in the near future and the true owner of the right of way in dispute will be determined.

An Extra Train Needed

There is a general demand throughout the eastern section of this state that during the rush to the fair at least, that the O R & N Co, put on a local between Huntington and Portland. This would relieve not only the travel but through traffic as well. Several of the commercial or organization along the line have taken the matter up with the railroad and action from the La Grande Commercial club would certainly be in order.

The fifteen horse power electric motor which has been ordered for several days for the Grande Ronde Cash Co, is expected to arrive soon. Here is another case where electricity has supplanted steam, and this firm will have their feed mill in readiness for the new crop.

Summer Schedule

The summer schedule of the Astoria & Columbia River Railroad has been inaugurated between Portland, Astoria, Gearhart and Seaside in connection with special round trip excursion tickets to all Clatsop and North Beach points, and trains leave Union Depot at 8:00 a m, daily and run through direct, arriving at Astoria at 11:30 a m, Gearhart 12:20 p m and Seaside at 12:30 p m.

The Portland and Seaside Flyer leaves Union Depot every Saturday at 2:30 p m, arriving at Astoria 5:50 p m and runs through direct, arriving at Gearhart 6:40 p m and Seaside at 6:50 p m.

Special commutation tickets, good for five round trips, are sold from Portland to same points for \$15.00, good to return until October 15th.

Saturday special round trip excursion tickets from Portland to all Clatsop and North Beach points on sale every Saturday at rate of \$2.50 for round trip, good to return Sunday.

Tickets sold from Portland to North Beach points are issued in connection with the O R & N steamers from Astoria, and baggage is transferred to and from depot and steamer dock at Astoria free of charge, and all tickets sold by the O R & N Co from Portland to Clatsop and North Beach points, are interchangeable and will be honored on trains of this company in either direction between Portland and Astoria.

Ticket sold at all O R & N stations and passengers wishing to go to points on Clatsop Beach should so specify in order to avoid confusing this popular resort with that of Long Beach, Washington, which is reached only by boat at Astoria, thus causing delays enroute.

Notice To Water Consumers

All persons knowing themselves to be in arrears for city water are hereby notified to call at the office of the city Recorder and settle at once. In order that there may be no mis understanding we cite the customer to the following section of the city ordinance. This ordinance will be enforced.

Section 28—The water rates shall be payable in advance at the office of the water superintendent on the first day of each month (except for meters which are payable on the first day of the succeeding month), and if not paid within the first ten days the water will be shut off the premises, as provided in Sections 26 and 27.

Later ordinance provides that water rates shall be payable to City Recorder instead of Water Superintendent.
