## SITE SELECTED FOR NEW SCHOOL HOUSE

Designs of Architect J. L. Slater Accepted--Bids to be Opened Aug. 30

The new school house for which the people voted bonds to the extent of \$12,000 last spring will be built on block 28, Predmore's Addition, which is bounded by Greenwood and Valley streets and Hill and Trawbridge. This property was owned by Calhoun & Co. of New Haven, Conn.

The plans of architect J. L. Slater were selected and bids will be opened at noon on August 30, for the construction of the building, which from the drawings submitted to the board will surely make a very creditable and commodious building, consisting of eight rooms with all the necessary cloak rooms and eat., usually found in an up to date school room.
