"MAN'S A MAN FOR A' THAT"

Cole Younger, the Once Noted Outlaw,
Now a Benefactor

To think of Cole Younger as a railroad operator is like thinking of the devil as a guardian of holy water, though we must do the redoubtable Cole the credit of saying that it has been many long years since he held up a railroad train. A special dispatch from Kansas City to the St. Louis Globe-Democrat says the exbandit is at the head of a company that is to construct a line called the Kansas City, Lee's Summit & Eastern. In order that people may not forget what he has been, Younger is quoted as saying:

"My birthday is Jan 15, and I am going to celebrate it by running the first electric to Lee's Summit. We will have the line completed to that point,

Jan 1. As a boy I got acquainted with every foot of the ground through which our road will run. Later in life I made a great deal of trouble in that neighborhood, and now I want, in a way, to make amends by seeing that my old friends and neighbors have facilities for bringing their hogs, cattle and corn to market. The road will be operated both as a freight and passenger line, and it will be equipped with freight cars. It is the purpose to ultimately extend the line to Jefferson City, where it will connect with the projected electric road from St. Louis, thus making a through electric railroad between Kansas and St. Louis."

Will Build Library

Springfield, Ill., Aug. 18.—William J. Bryan has made known his plans to give a library to the town of Salem, Ill., his birthplace. The library building, ground for which will be broken December 11, will occupy the site on which the house in which Bryan was born now stands. The old Bryan homestead will be moved across the street opposite the library. Mr. Bryan will be present and deliver a speech when the first earth is turned, and, immediately following the ceremony, will depart for New York, to embark on a tour of Europe.

A Notable Oregonian

William K. Allen, who died at Newberg, Oregon, on Sunday last, was the inventor of the Allen fruit dryer and was for many years past closely identified with the fruit-evaporating industry of the northwest. He was at the head of the Allen Evaporating company, which he organized, and which owns and evaporates large evaporating plants in Oregon, Washington and Idaho. The Allen evaporator is used more extensively in Oregon than any make of driers. Mr. Allen was 72 years of age.
