ARGUE CASES WITH TORCHES

Council Idaho Aug 25—The worst forest fire that has visited this section this season has been burning for the past four days on sections 21, 22 and 23, township 17, north, range 1 east. Nearly all of these sections have been burned over and it is estimated that already something like 5,000,000 feet of timber has been destroyed.

It is said that the fire was started intentionally by parties who have a grudge against the government's forest reserve policy, this being on the Walker reserve. As the persons alleged to be responsible for the fire are well known here, it is more than likely that charges will be preferred against them and that prosecutions will follow.

Payette Idaho Aug 25—Joseph Lawrence, the Idaho convict captured at Pendleton Tuesday, while passing through Payette last night jumped through the car window in a desperate effort to escape. A moment later Deputy Warden James Mills, of the penitentiary, went through the same window and recaptured his charge, holding him here until this morning when they boarded the train for Boise. Lawrence almost effected his escape from the Pendleton county jail where he was being held, by digging his way out. The deputy heard the noise and

The residence of Jap Chandler, a farmer resident near Elgin has been broken into and ransacked by burglars. The family was away at the time. The thieves got about \$25 in cash that was in the children's safety bank, a gold watch, several other articles of jewelry and some clothing. Entrance was gained by picking the lock on one of the doors.

Street Car at Last

Walla Walla, Aug 25.—The first carload of ties for the Walla Walla street railway system arrived in the city yesterday over the W & C R road. Several cars of steel rails are on the way from Seattle and are expected to arrive today or tomorrow. A construction gang will come from the Sound in a few days, and work will begin immediately on the line of the Walla Walla Valley Traction company, which is to connect the business district of Walla Walla with the suburbs and outlying country.
