Car of Horses Burned

Boise, Aug. 30—Word comes from Caldwell that a carload of horses and household goods was burned between Caldwell and Parma on Saturday evening, the man traveling with the car to attend to the needs of the animals barely escaped with his life. A man from Caldwell, so the story goes, had loaded the car with his domestic effects and included in it eight fine draft horses. With these effects he started for the west, to establish himself in a new location.

The train of which this car was a part had hardly started, however, when the car took fire. The inmate finally attracted the attention of the train crew, and the car was set out upon the first sidetrack at Parma, but it was then all ablaze, and none of the horses nor any of the other property in the car could be taken from it.

Northwest News

The State Deaf and Dumb school at Salem will open September 20 with 80 pupils—20 more than attended last year.

The American board of foreign missions of the Congregational church, will meet in Seattle September 14 to 18. A special train will be run starting from Boston.

The clear profits of the salmon canneries of Vancouver, B. C., this year are estimated at \$1,000,000. It is the biggest year in the history of the business in that locality.

In 1905 wool crop of Washington amounted to 9,800,000 pounds, divided as follows: Eastern Washington, 4,000,000 pounds; Yakima 4,000,000 pounds; Wenatchee, 1,800,000; Puget Sound, 300,000. The Angora goat wool clip is much larger than any previous year.

Walla Walla will celebrate Labor day with appropriate exercises. Five horse races and a five mile automobile race will be among the features.

For Civil Service

Civil service examinations for city mail carrier and clerk will be held in every first-class postoffice in this state during the latter part of November. Applicants desiring to take these examinations must be between the ages of 18 and 45 years, at least 5 feet 4 inches in height, and must have application on file 30 days before the examination. City residence is not required. These positions pay from \$600 to \$1200 a year.

Amish Colony

A. H. Candland, the Union Pacific emigration agent, is in the city with a part of nine representatives of an Amish colony, from Illinois. These people are looking over the west with the intention of finding a suitable location for a colony. They have been here several days and have looked over the valley quite thoroughly, and state that they are well satisfied with the appearance of the Grand Ronde but will look at the country around Portland and also go up to Albany, where there is already an Amish settlement. An Observer representative called at the hotel and endeavored to learn something of the Amish religion, but about all that could be learned was that their creed was somewhat similar to the German Lutherians, and that four years ago the entire sect numbered about forty eight thousand members. The sect is largely composed of farmers, and there is no question but that they would make a valuable addition to our population.
