Filed a Big Mortgage

Involves Two Million of Dollars

One of the largest mortgages filed in recent years went on record yesterday at the county recorder's office, and from the nature of the instrument it certainly indicates that the much talked of electric railroad which is to encircle this valley, is soon to become a reality.

The Eastern Oregon Development Co yesterday filed a mortgage to the American Loan & Trust Co., of Boston Mass., given by the Central railroad of Oregon, which has succeeded the Oregon Development Co., a corporation organized under the laws of Maine, and have filed their supplementary articles with the secretary of the State of Oregon, and C. E. Cochran is made attorney in fact.

This mortgage is given to secure the issue of bonds to the amount of \$2,000,000, \$500,000 of this amount is to be available just as soon as the papers can be returned to Boston, and the balance of the \$1,500,000 is to be available when the first twenty-five miles of the road is completed, and then \$30,000 per mile advanced as completed.

The officers of the Oregon Central Railroad Co as shown on the mortgage gives Harvey Harding as president, and Horace B. Perkins as secretary.

The mortgage is a voluminous affair consisting of 100 folios dealing with coupons and payment of interest and many matters of minor detail.

This mortgage was received by Attorney Cochran in Union yesterday and in company with Mr. Marr, who is one of the interested parties, drove over and had it placed on record.

In keeping with the policy of the parties who originated this undertaking they stated that they had nothing more for publication than what might naturally be inferred by the placing of the mortgage on record which was public property, that it was another step towards the completion of the enterprise.

In reply to the question if it was a fact that as reported several weeks ago that rails and rolling stock for twenty-five miles of the road had been purchased was correct, they replied that a careful reading of the mortgage just filed would show such material was covered in the instrument.

One thing is evident and has been apparent from the inception of the enterprise and that is, several thousand dollars have been invested in securing rights of way, franchises, data, etc., and that no bonus has been asked or demanded in any way, and that in case the enterprise does not mature as they and the public generally hope it will they will be the principal losers.

In absence of definite information we give our readers all the information we have and they can guess at the results as they view it. This last move, however, looks like something will be doing before long.

DIE AT THE SAME HOUR

New York, Aug 29.—Separated by 10,000 miles of distance, Mrs. June Johnson and her husband, Allan Johnson, a Little Rock, Ark., banker, met death almost simultaneously today. At the precise hour when Mrs. Johnson's body was taken from the bathing waters of Coney island a telegram reached here to inform her of the death of her husband. The wife was a magazine contributor who wrote under the pen name of Helen Dixie Johnson, and the husband was president of the National Exchange bank of Little Rock.
