Heroic Women

Tampico Mex Sept 1—Further de-
tails of the recent conflict between
American colonists at the Minas Vie-
jas ranch and a large force of Indians
tell how that but for the heroism of
two American women of the colony a
wholesale massacre of the little band
of foreigners by Indians would have
taken place.

When the band of 200 armed In-
dians arrived at the colony and made
a threatening demonstration, Mrs
James Ravencroft and Mrs T L Poole,
wives of two of the colonists mounted
horses and rode at breakneck speed
through the line of Indians and carried
a message to Rev B F Hunter at Ci-
udad del Maiz, asking for help. Rev
Mr Hunter notified the chief of police
of the district, and a relief force was
quickly sent to the colony, arriving
there just as the Indians were about
to begin an attack.
