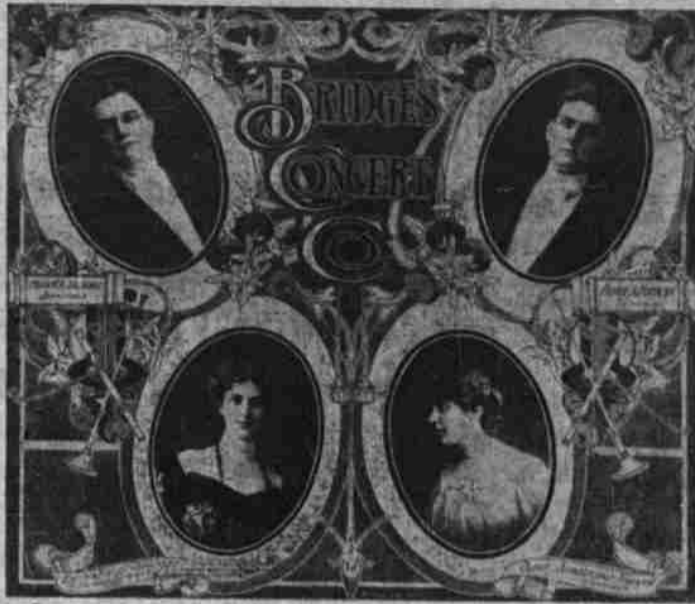
## LA GRANDE SCHOOL OF MUSIC
