FOREST FIRES ARE STILL BURNING

Sampter, Sept. 13—In the mountains above Sampter heavy forest fires are still raging. Along the line of the Sampter Valley railroad, between Sampter and Tipton the fires have been scattered and largely extinguished. Further over on the other mountain there is one fire burning nearly five miles long, which in some places is very fierce and is destroying considerable timber.

It is understood that the forest rangers are putting men at work to extinguish the flames, but so far efforts have not succeeded very well. The season has been the driest one in 15 or 20 years. There is no water to be had in the hills and even at Tipton they have to carry their drinking water from distant springs. All placer mining ceases several weeks and the people are praying for rain.

Contract Let

The school board upon opening the bids for the construction of the new school house found them all above their limit and rejected them and let the contract to J. L. Slater for the sum of \$12,500. The building is to be an eight room, two story building and is expected to be completed by the first of the year and will be if the weather does not interfere. This price does not include the heating or furnishing.
