September Term 1905
In the matter of the County Road petitioned for by J W Cummins et al. It was ordered that the board of County Road Viewers meet at the beginning of said proposed road on the 2nd day of Sept. 1905—view and lay out said proposed road as by law directed.

In the matter of the proposed road petitioned for by Dills Randall et al. It was ordered that the appeals for damages by W M Pierce George Miller be denied and that the files and records in this matter be submitted to Clarence H Crawford District Attorney.

The petition of Dr C M Ramsdell to change location of certain County Road was continued for the term.

The petition of William Miller to vacate certain streets in Riverside Addition to La Grande, was granted. The petition of Frank Kilpatrick for license to store grain was granted.

The monthly allowances for various indigent persons were allowed as follows: George May, \$8.00, Ella Neason, \$12.00, O W Souder \$10.00, John Hilderbrand, \$8.00, L W Bagel, \$8.00.

The application of George Palmer for the appointment of G M Byrkit, Dennis McCullough and W T Arnold as fire rangers was granted.

The application of J L Linebarger for transportation for his son Oscar a deaf mute, was allowed, and the clerk ordered to draw a warrant on the contingent fund for the amount.

The petition of W A Warren asking that the order heretofore made in this court vacating certain lots and blocks Freedmore's Add. to La Grande, was granted.

The claim of J H Hutchinson for damages was continued for the term. The petition of John L Ross for a road of public easement was granted, and it was ordered that the board of county road viewers meet at said proposed road on Sept 13rd, 1905 to view and lay out said road as by law directed.

The matter of insuring the Court House (City Hall) at La Grande was referred to M A Harrison, County Judge.
