COST OF SEWERS PER FOOT

Eight-inch sewer pipe, laid, complete, for 46 cents per foot!

That is the record that has been made by James Kennedy, the contractor on the main sewer, in laying 1319 feet of sewer pipe in Boise, according to figures submitted to members of the city council by the city engineer. The figures given represents only his actual cost—outlay, and make no allowance for contractor's profits.

This report on the actual expenditure in laying sewer in Boise is especially interesting in the light of the bids submitted 10 days ago for laying 23,000 feet of sewer laterals of the eight inch size, which run from \$1.15 per foot on up. These bids were rejected, and it is expected the council will shortly re-advertise for more bids.

It is stated, seemingly upon unquestionable authority, that the manufacturers of sewer pipe stand ready to deliver their pipe L. O. B. Boise for a price that makes it cost the contractor 23 cents per foot, when bought in quantities of carload lots or better. The engineer's office kept track of all the other expenses connected with the laying of the sections of pipe in question, including the hauling of the pipe, cost of sand, cement and other materials, and the entire pay roll of the laborers. To the sum thus obtained an amount of 7 per cent was added as an accident bond, making the total cost 46 cents per foot, without profit.

This pipe was laid about eight and a half feet below the surface, deeper than the proposed laterals are to be laid, but the cost was decreased from the fact that the trenches were entirely dry, no water being found.
