PROSPEROUS ELGIN BRANCH TOWN

Splendid Industrial Showing of Grande Ronde Valley Town.

Imbler will surprise you. If you have not visited this bustling little burg during the past year take a day off and see for yourself how the town has grown. A visit to Imbler will cause a thrill of surprise to speed through your nerve centers in a manner to cause you to hunt up a real estate agent and buy in a corner lot. Imbler has corner lots, as well as other towns. There are mills and stores, and lumber piles, and hotels, and a harness shop, a blacksmith shop, and all the other places of business and pleasure which contribute to the activities of a live branch town. Imbler is surrounded by one of the richest farming and fruit sections to be found in the state and therefore no reason why it should not thrive. Within the past two years it has more than doubled in population, as demonstrated by the large addition recently added to the public school building. The Observer man found the Imbler Flouring mill running at

top speed, turning out flour at the rate of eight barrels every twelve hours, the warehouses all busy receiving wheat, and the lumber yards exhibiting a scene of activity. Alexander & Hall, the blacksmiths, were busy plying their trade while carpenters were putting the finishing touches to the building and on every hand were signs of prosperity and life. The orchard industry is receiving considerable attention by those who see a future for the Grande Ronde Valley apple, and at present there are several large tracts near Imbler, devoted exclusively to this fruit. M. L. Causey has one tract of one hundred acres which he planted last year. On the tract are five thousand apple trees, and remarkable as the statement may sound, not one tree of the five thousand was lost. There is not a vacancy in a single row. The next time you have the blues take the train for Imbler and the visit will cheer you up for the rest of the season.
