Walla Walla, Wash, Oct 13—Representative J H Dobbin of Joseph, has received the following from General Manager J P O'Brien concerning the construction of the Wallowa branch of the O R & N:

"Dear Sir:—I am desirous to do so, you are authorized to make the statement that this company will extend the Elgin branch to Joseph, and the line will be in operation within 18 months or two years after we have matters in shape so we can force our way through the canyon.
