This bill was introduced in Congress at the last session, and provides for absolute prohibition through out the District of Columbia, Representative Webber of Ohio, who framed the measure, claims that he has enough votes to insure its passage at the coming session. The liquor cealers will present vigorous opposition to prevent its enactment.
