It the people will, by their action at the primary election demonatrate that they can and will nominate fit and clean men to be voted for at the Juse election, by so doing they will hanish from our political anchinery the laat remnant of Iuedalism that has controlled political partios in this state and educated the young voters into the narrow conseption of politics and civil duties that the prime object and purpope of parties and partizanship is to secure a fat office for the big man of the the smaller offices among bis favorites. The result of bossism is that tate indebledness and county indebtednees to $\$ 5,000$ our state debt is more than ten times above the limit, and some of our counties more than twenty fold. Notwithstanding these enormous debts the people have been annually raxed heavily. Now that the people have a chance to take atate and county matters into hoped they will realise their re sponsibility and act and take charge of state and county management.
