JERRY SIMPSON

The death of Jerry Simpson and the numerous references made to him as "Sockless Jerry" recalls a custom that has long prevailed of attempting to bring western men into contempt by fixing a derogatory nickname to them. The Tories in the colonies thought to eliminate Washington by calling him a buckskin colonel but they changed their smile at Yorktown. Jackson's political enemies to make him appear ridiculous to the people in the older states represented him as carrying a big hickory club at "hoss races" and shooting matches, which he was ever ready to use to secure purses and turkeys whether won or not for his friends, and they dubbed him 'Old Hickory'.

The secessionists, pro-slavery aristocrats and their tools thought they had forever closed the door to the president's room in the national capitol when they represented Lincoln as an ignorant rail splitter. But the aristocratic Lee when he handed his sword to Lincoln's general at Appomattox found that if he had split rails and never attended college he was wise and strong enough to prevent the high toned southern chivalry from splitting the Union.

The bankers and money loan-ers in slick hats and silken stockings felt that when they had got the people to believe that Jerry Simpson wore no socks by calling him "Sockless Jerry" they had silenced his tongue, but when he appeared in congress they found him a match for their brightest cham-pains in debate.
