MANY TAKING UP OSTEOPATHY

Trouble at Woodley

The mining property up Grande Ronde river, known as the Carson Consolidated Hydraulic Mining company, was attached today by creditors who had become tired of waiting for their pay. The principal creditors are La Grande merchants who have furnished supplies to the management. The amount outstanding against the company, including a \$2000 labor account totals up to about \$6000. Supt. J R Elmendorf was seen this afternoon and stated that he was also a creditor of the concern, and also placed his account in the hands of an attorney for collection. He states that his last report was accepted by the officers of the company as satisfactory, and he is at a loss to understand what has caused the trouble. The company has already expended \$60,000 on the mine and he does not think it probable that the company will allow this comparatively small amount to bring about the abandonment of the mine. Mr. Elmendorf feels very keenly the delicate position in which he is placed but is strongly in the hope that matters may soon be straightened out to the satisfaction of all.

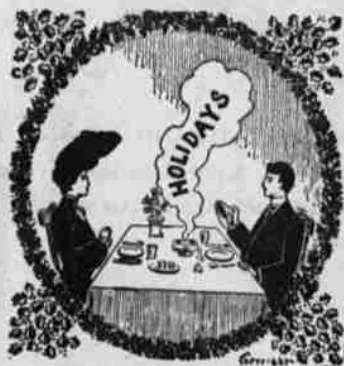
