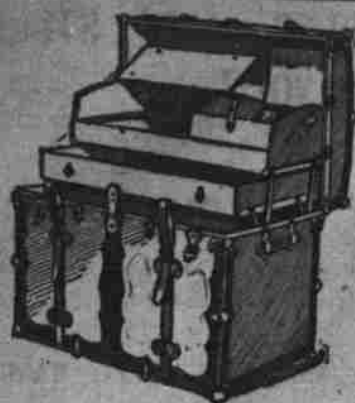

Valuable Prize

El Paso, Tex., Nov. 6.—Col. W. G. Greene, of New York and El Paso, the noted copper miner and millionaire, has wired a draft for \$1000 for first prize in the rock drilling contest to be held in this city during the meeting of the American Mining Congress, Nov. 14 to 18.

Already entries have been made from Canada, Mexico, Tombstone and Bisbee, Arizona; Tonopah and Goldfield, Nevada; Gripple Creek, Colo., and several places in Sonora.

The best drillers in the country will contest for the prize and attempt to make new records. The world's record was established here two years ago and has never been broken.
