To Develop Grande Ronde Quartz Mines

A new mining company has been formed which gives promise of materially aiding the development of the Grande Ronde river mines.

The strike of the main vein is north and south with a dip 70 degrees to the east. The width of the vein of the ore deposit is three to seven feet wide.

Many assays have been made on this ore and they run from \$1.50 to \$168 a ton, and the average assay shows a value of \$30 a ton.

It is the intention of the company to place a limited quantity of the treasury stock upon the market, the proceeds of which will be used in taking out ore.
