NEW O.R.&N. MAP

The Harriman system has compiled a wall map of the northwest which is as near correct as can be made, with the data now obtainable. The map, which is pronounced by government officers to be the best ever published, covering this particular section of the country is now being turned out by Poole Bros. of Chicago, and General Passenger Agent A. L. Craig thinks they will be ready for distribution within another month.

Connections have been the first consideration; consequently the curves in railroad lines are shown where they really run. In addition to ordinary topographical features and railroads found on the map, the forest reserves, land withdrawn from settlement under the national irrigation act and the principal withdrawals under the Carey act are shown in their respective localities, printed in colors.

Mr. Craig has arranged for a general distribution of the maps when they are shipped from Chicago in December.

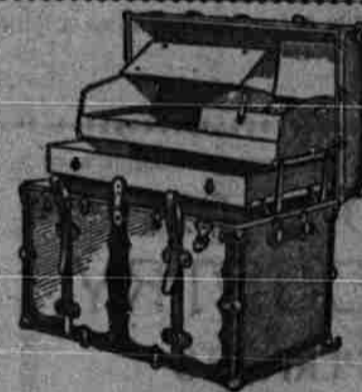
