RIGHTS OF WOMEN

The fate of empires and fall of kings: Quacks of state must each produce his

And even children lisp the rights of man: One sacred right, just let me mention, The rights of women merit some atten-

It has been a long time since the great Scotch bard wrote the above, and allthese years, about 220, the women have patiently waited for the attention due their rights by the men. Growing somewhat anxious and thinking that a little urging on their part will hasten the day when the chivalry and sense of justice of the men of Oregon will induce them to recognize the rights of women to a voice in making the laws they and their children have to obey, and to carry out which they pay taxes on their property, at the next June election they will ask the men of Oregon to give them the right to vote.

To present their claim to be treated as equals to the men of Oregon the women who met in a national convention in Portand on last Wednesday planned an active campaign in Oregon next spring and made arrangments to have the state thoroughly canvassed.

From the Oregon Journal's account of the meeting the following is taken:

"The women decided to organize the state fully for the campaign by which they hope to win equal suffrage. To this and the national organization will send some of its most conspicuous speakers to Oregon. Miss Gregg. Miss Clay and Miss Laughlin already are here. They will be joined by Miss Ida Porter Boyer of Pennsylvania, who will conduct a press bureau; Mrs Clara B. Colby, editor of the Woman's Tribune; Mrs Julia Woodworth of Oklahoma, Miss Harriet May Mills of New York and, finally, Rev. Anna Shaw, who will arrive shortly after the close of the national coevention in Washington D. C., next Februrary. A state central committee is being selected to carry on

In 1900 there were 131,261 white males entitled to vote at general elections in Oregon and 560 negroes, but nary white or black woman
