NEED WHITE FARMERS

Washington, Dec. 16—"What we need in the Hawaiian Islands is a larger influx of small farmers of Anglo-Saxon or any good European stock," said Mr. Sydney Ballou, a prominent Honolulu lawyer, at the Shireham today.

"If we could get a goodly number of white agriculturists, I believe that there would be no reason to fear for the future of the country. Our government will give such settlers the best inducements in the way of obtaining fertile lands at a low cost. A great many leases of public lands are going to gradually expire, and these lands can be obtained on the most favorable terms. The immigration of the yellow races has about run its course in Hawaii, and in considering what is to be done, about the only rational expedient seems to be to invite colonies from the United States or from Europe.
