**REGARDING
WALLOWA
BRIDGE**

The Elgin Recorder in an article with reference to the Wallowa bridge quotes Commissioner Blumenstein as follows:
"When our county judge was at Enterprise it was agreed to have the permanent bridge erected where the old structure stood, but now Wallowa county wants it placed about four hundred feet above the site of the old bridge. The stand taken by Wallowa county is occasioned by the fact that the O. R. & N. Co. wants the location of the new structure changed for the reason that the line of their new railroad into Wallowa county crosses the location of the old structure, and Wallowa county not wanting to antagonize the company in any manner is willing to make the concession at most any price while the county court of Union county wants it received for the accommodation. Thus the matter stands."

"CHRISTIAN WORK" SAYS FAIR PLAY
