REGARDING THE GREEN MISTLETOE

While we are compelled to have our supply of mistletoe shipped in from other places, nevertheless we get it and it plays no small part in Christmas festivities. In fact it has played a leading part in Yule festivities from time immemorial. Mistletoe was borrowed from pagans and Christianized by the lapse of centuries. Formerly it was not used for the purpose that romantic youths have turned it to. Even before the birth of Christ the Persians used it in their sacred rites and the Indian priests in some parts of India still incorporate it in their ceremonies. Scandinavian mythology would not be complete without mistletoe.

The Druids of England are the ones from whom we get it. The Druid priests descended from magi and wise men and believed that the mistletoe was "all healing." The gathering of the vine was attended by solemn ceremonies, and the oxen used to haul it to the temples were afterwards sacrificed. The Druids believed in the plant's healing powers and all kinds of healing potions were made from it. As civilization advanced and superstition decreased the mistletoe lost its religious significance, but not its popularity.

HOW ICE HEATS THE FRUIT CARS

The use of ice for heating purposes is one of the oddities of our modern civilization. Often it happens that a train carrying freight from the south to the northern market encounters a cold spell while enroute. If the temperature goes below a certain point, the perishable merchandise will be ruined. But it has been asserted that such a misfortune may be prevented by covering the fruit car with a coat of ice—a thing easily accomplished by turning a hose upon it and allowing the water to freeze until the whole vehicle is enveloped in a glassy and glittering blanket. It may, indeed, be appropriately called a blanket, inasmuch as it prevents the radiation of heat from the interior of the car. The ice being a good non-conductor, the warmth is retained and the fruit, or possibly it may be vegetables, goes on its way unspoiled even by zero weather.—Philadelphia North American.
