## STARTLING DISCLOSURE IS MADE

St. Petersburg, Jan. 3.—The Novoye Vremya prints a statement attributed to Rojstevsky saying, "At the battle of Tsushima the British squadron at Weiha Weiha orders to attack the Russian fleet in event of a Japanese defeat."

The minister of war has issued an order forbidding officers of the army joining any kind of a political union. Prof. Migulin, a financial expert, is prepared to itemize the estimate losses in the result of the uprising. He declares the direct losses are \$175,000,000 and indirect \$900,000,000, and the grand total over a billion.

### BIG CASUALTIES

Moscow January 3, up to date It is estimated that the total casualties of the revolt are 15,000. A majority of the victims were peaceful citizens. The city is quiet and it is believed that the revolutionists will be starved into submission.

## NEW TAX LEVY BRINGS MORE MONEY

While the tax levy within this city and school district has been reduced from 22 mills to 16 mills, the property valuation has increased to that extent that 16 mills will produce more money this year than the 22 mills did last year by \$1822.41.

### LA GRANDE DISTRICT

The taxable property within the La Grande school district for the year 1904, was \$755,181 upon which was levied a 9 mill tax, which brought in taxes to the amount of \$6796.63. The levy for 1905 a 7 mill tax upon a tax roll of \$1,128,720, (an increase over 1904 of \$368,539), will bring in taxes to the amount of \$7,865.04, while the tax levy has been reduced two mills the increase in valuation results in a seven mill tax netting \$1053.41 more than the 9 mill tax last year.

### CITY OF LA GRANDE

The taxable property within the city limits for 1904 upon which a 13 mill tax was levied was \$336,715. The same in 1905 being \$921,275 (an increase over 1904 of \$584,560) a levy of 9 mills will raise the city tax of \$85,848, as against \$7757.50.
