## REGULATOR WILL BE REPLACED

The Dalles, Feb. 9.—People all along the river have been interested to know what plans have been made to fill the place of the Regulator, destroyed by fire at St. Johns recently, and have hoped that whether a steamer was built or bought it will be the namesake of the Regulator. It has not as yet been decided which will be done, but it has been given out that the company will need another vessel shortly, as it is the intention to take the Bailey Gatzert out on the ways to get her in shape for the spring and summer season. She will again be operated as an excursion boat.

The boiler and engines of the Regulator it is thought, were not injured by the fire to any great extent. They have been hauled out from the ruins and placed on a platform for close inspection. It is said that enough has been learned to show that the engines are in good condition. The only thing noticed wrong with the boiler is that one of the plates was slightly sprung. When this is riveted it is believed the boiler will be as good as ever. Should such prove to be the case, the company will build a new boat and equip her with the old machinery.

It is pointed out by the general manager of the line that the carrying capacity of the steamers will be taxed during the next year or two transporting material to the north bank road. With the Gatzert off the freight run and used exclusively as an excursion boat the fleet would be rather small if another craft is not procured. It is supposed that in early spring the steamer Chas. R. Spencer will be placed in service again between Portland and The Dalles. Captain Spencer, the owner, is still in the east, but he is expected home the latter part of this month.

### GRANGE FOR SUITABLE LEGISLATION

The legislative committee of the national grange met in Washington in January in the interest of several measures pending in Congress, directly affecting agriculture upon which the national grange has taken unanimous favorable action. The committee is composed of N. J. Bachelder, N. B. Norris, and Aaron Jones. Those visited included President Roosevelt, the interstate commerce commission, Chairman Payne of the committee on ways and means, the committee of agriculture, Postmaster Gen. Cortelyou, Sec. Wilson, and the committee of interstate committee and postoffices and post roads.

The committee was accompanied by Gov. Bell of Vermont. On every hand excellent hospitality and an attentive ear was directed toward the committee. Patrons throughout the country should write their senators and representatives in congress to favor bill looking toward reasonable rate regulation; removal of internal revenue tax on alcohol rendered unfit for beverage purposes; national aid for highways, and continuation of rural mail service. Sec. Wilson met the committee cordially and assured the members that he is in favor of all the legislation endorsed by the national grange, and some of those matters were taken up and discussed in detail at the interview.—Orange Judd Farmer.
