The last Oregon Logisiature passed several acts pertaining to public roads. which it would be woll if our people were
to hunt up and read. Senate bill 162 appropriated $\$ 500$ to be oxpended under the direct direction of the Prosident of
the Oregon Good Roads Association in holding good roads conventions for the promotion of good roads in Oregon. courts in Oregen to improve county roads by graveling, draining, grading, planking. is generally known as the Tutit ho provides that the resident purnere of real estata residing within two miles on either side of a county road and one mile bayond the ends who wish to have it finproved by grading, graveling, planking, corduray ing or macadamizing can have the desired improvernent done, expenses of the same ostate adjacent theroto and benefitoo theroby, by a majority of the land ownels of the county whose lands are within two miles of the road or improvement, presonting the county $=$ court with a petition
This law has been on the statute boo since Feb. 22. 1905. It is quito longthy law and may be found on page 410 to and including page 421 of the ganeral laws of Oregon passed at the lagislature of Oregon in 1905.

Feb. 27 -Siliverton the first town in Orogon to take advanta of the Tuttil law for the improvement of roads in this vieinity. At the good roads meeting held in the opera house last Saturday, where more than 300 farmer and business men were present, it wat decided by a unanimous rote of the meeting to build a macadimizod road from this city to connect with the Scotts Mille Mount Angel road, a distance of fiva miles. It is estimated that the cost of work will bo anount to \$15,000 and the county court has offered to cont. The $\$ 1,000 \mathrm{a}$ mile or $\$ 5,000$ and the balanc will be raised by assessing property
owners along the road as provided for in the Tuttil law, and by donition from the city. The city council has offered a good liberal donation and there is no longer a doubt as to the success of the movement:"
