ABANDON A NAVAL STATION

(Scripps News Association)
Washington, D. C. Mar. 6.—There is a great desire in the Navy Department to be relieved of further expense on account of the abandoned naval station at Port Royal. It cost nearly \$15,000 to maintain the useless establishment last year. The value of the plant which could be used elsewhere, in less than \$500,000 and much of the material, including stone buildings, a decaying dry dock of large dimensions, and obsolete machinery could not be given away, much less sold for money. This is an unfortunate state of affairs, but it has been found that the Port Royal plant is of no use whatever and that the sooner it is disposed of the better for the government. The suggestion of final disposition and abandonment has been before the House of Naval Committee, and it is expected the description of the conditions is fully appreciated in Congress. The Navy Department is pushing work as rapidly as possible on the new navy yard at Charleston, which however, presents an additional reason for spending no more money, even for the protection of property, at Port Royal.

TO REFORM ELECTORIAL CONGRESS

(Scripps News Association)
New York, Mar. 5.—The second National Conference for the Reform of Primary and Election Laws will open here today and will remain in session three days. The subjects for discussion will be primary laws, election laws, with special reference to the form of the ballots and corrupt practices as now in force in the various states, together with proposed modifications. Representatives of nearly every regular and independent political and civic organization throughout the United States, many members of Congress and mayors of large cities are here to attend the conference and it is expected that the proceedings of the conference will be unusually interesting. Among the speakers who will address the conference are many men of wide experience in matters political.
