## SERIOUS FOR INDEPENDENTS

(Scripps News Association)

Topeka, Kan., Mar. 7-The action the railroads entering this state, in deciding to discontinue transporting crude and refined oil at the rates named in the maximum freight sate law enacted by the state Legislature a year ago. has caused finers in this state. The railroads declare that the rates named in the law are dis-deficiency, and there is nothing to do criminative and confiscatory, and that they would lose money should they transport oil at those figures.
The maximum freight rate law was

one of four enacted by the Kansas legis-lature during the height of the anti-Standard Oil Company crusade a year ago and has been the most serviceable of the four. It out the freight rates on oil iquarely in two and enabled the independnt producers to find a market for their w grade or fuel oil. It also enabled the dependent refiners to market their product on a parity with the Staudard Oil Company in Kansas. Both the state refinery law and the act making oil pipe lines common carriers have already been declared unconstitutional. The independint producers and refiners will now make me court a decision confirming the validity of the rate law. Feeling among independent producers here is strong, and there is a prevalent belief that the Gil Trust influence is behind the action of the railroads.
