and some recent interpretations of the Monroe doctrine as made by Presiden Roosevelt and Secrotary Taft have

front. The powars of the President in foreign mattors and the constitutional powers of the Senate have been involvod
in the discussion. And, finally, the decision of the Democratic Senators to take caucuss action against the Santo Doming
treaty, and the revolt from the caucus Senator Patterion of Colorido have created something like a political sensa The Santo Domingo treaty was nego tiated by the President and placed befci the Senate last year. That body adjourned without action and the trasty, there fore, remained pending. Shorly after the adjournment of the Senate, the President received a cablegram which
may become historic. In the usual eco nomical verbiago of cablegrans, it in formed the President that the Santo Domingo Covernment, under tha pressure of forign croditors and of domestic
peril, offered to place in charge of the custom-houses in its Southern ports and in four Northern ports a citizan of
United States, under whoso adminiatra tion of the customs 45 per cant. of the money was to go to the Dominican Government and 55 per cent. to be deposited in Naw York for distribution among the pending treaty. The creditors were alt or practically all willing to accept sych an arrangement. It was made. Presi-
dent Roosovelt "nominated" for receiver of the duties Colonel George R. Colton, a retired officer of the United States army. He was appointed by President Morales and he entered upon his duties. The arrangement is one somewhat similar
that provided for in the pending treaty but there are difforences. Senato Spooner thinks the difforences are im portant. Senator Tilman thinks thoy dent with usurpation of power in making such an arrangement when the troaty was still pending.
Many cities of the Northwest are taking an unusal interest in those things that
