**DYNAMITE AT WALLACE**

Spokane, March 17.—Following the attempt three weeks ago to blow up the Standard mill near Wallace, a bomb containing over 30 pounds of dynamite was found this morning on the ice on the south fork of the Coueur d'Alene river back of the fire station and in the very heart of Wallace.  
The finding of the infernal machine which contained enough of the explosive to send hundreds of people to their deaths set Wallace wild with excitement.  
The bomb was discovered by William Schullenberg, a member of the fire department, while he was clearing away the ice in the street behind the fire station to allow the refuse to be carried away.  
Schullenberg dealt the bomb five blows with his pick before he discovered what it was.  
The dynamite failed to explode because it was frozen, to which fact Schullenberg owes his life.

The marriage of King Alfonso to Princess Ena of Battenberg has been officially announced by Premier Moret. The union will probably take place in June.

The Chinese Governor of Manchuria is anxious for the Japanese abandonment of the country, and as soon as this end is reached it will be open to the world for commerce.

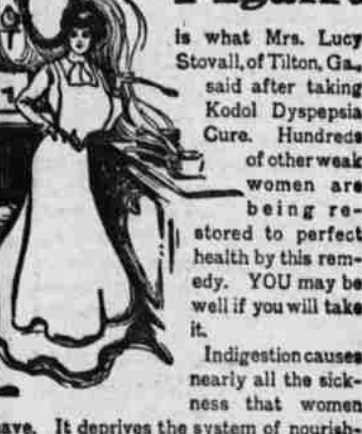
