Andrew D. White, ex-President of Cornell University, ex-Ambassador to Germany-scholar, publicist, humanitanell students a few weeks ago on the problem of "High Crime in the United States." The basis of his address was the fact that more murders are committed every year in the United States than any other country.

It is said that society has no right to put murderers to death. In my opinion society must fall back on the law of self-preservation. It should gut through and make war, in my opinion, for its life. Life imprisonment is not possible, because there is no life imprisonment.

In the next year 9,000 people will be murdered. As I stand here today I tell you that 9,000 are doomed to death with all the cruelty of the criminal heart, and with no regard for home and families, and two-thirds will be due to the maudlin sentiment sometimes called mercy.

I have no sympathy for the criminal. My sympathy is for those who will be murdered, for their families and for their

Young men, like Jerome, like Folk and Hughes, resolve never to be servants of criminals, but to do your best to punish crime as it should be punished.
