While there may be more or less speculation as to many of the nominations, there is no question as to the nomination on the Republican ticket for the offices of clerk, recorder and treasurer and their re-election is just as certain as their nomination.

It appears that the state of Oregon is to be "presented" with a "gold brick" in the shape of the old Barlow toll road. That is the people are to be asked to vote on the proposition to purchase the same for \$24,000. The road is little short of a right of way, and before June the voters should investigate before voting authority for the state to purchase.

One week from tomorrow the voters will be put to the test. For years they have clamored for political freedom from the bosses. Now they have it but it remains to be seen whether they are willing to do the thinking for themselves. The primary law places absolute dictation as to party nominations and if the people turn out and participate in the primaries the results will be satisfactory and there will be no opportunity to raise the hue and cry that the present system is not the thing we want. There will be an effort to restore the old system if there is the least possible chance. The way to prevent this is to roll up a large vote at the primaries.

A WORD OF FAITH
