MILITARY WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY

Paris, April 14.-For some time com nunication by wireless telegraphy has been possible between the Eiffel Tower and Belfort, on the Eastern frontier. At present the engineers are trying to dis-cover to what degree their wireless messages can be intercepted and falsified. An apparatus fitted in the grounds of the Military Asrostatic school at Meudon has been communicating with the office of a divisional commander on the eastern frontier and at the same time messages have been exchanged between the Eiffel Tower and an apparatus fitted in a captive baloon, lying over one of the frontier fortresses. No statement has been made as to the result of the experiments.
