************ TO ENCOURAGE MARKSMANSHIP

Every conceivable inducement is being held out to interest able-bodied citizens 11 of the United States in acquiring proficency in the handling of the rifle and 'small arm" in order that, in case of an emergency, the Government will have a reserve of expert marksmen to take the 17 field at a moment's notice, and defend the 18 country against invasion.

Not being content with providing ways and means, at an enormous expense, for 22 the training of the citizen soldiers in 23 accurate and effective rifle shooting, by 24 providing for state and national compe- 25 titive range contests and tempting 26 trophies as a mark of efficiency, these 28 same inducements and privileges are now 29 offered to the private citizen in no wise 30 connected with a military or scmi- 31 military organization.

All that is necessary is to join a rifle club and begin to practice. These clubs Date 21st are being formed thro-ghout the United Date 11th-18th States and are branch organizations of No. days clear 20 the National Rifle Association of America. Cloudy 6 an organization that has been approved by the War Department and permitted to participate on equal terms with the military teams at the National contest for marksmanship honors and medals.
