ELGIN AGAINST IT

The people of Union county think that Elgin voters are so sore over McLeod's defeat that they will even up with La Grande by supporting the county division candidate. This is a wrong impression as the people of Elgin are opposed to this move and will oppose it to the bitter end.—Elgin Recorder.

Last week the Union papers were astonished to think that Mr. Holmes' nomination meant a campaign on the issue of county division. The work of the Union people was too transparent to fool anyone, and the Union Republican this week in admitting the issue, lets itself down easy in the following manner.

"There is a persistent effort to inject a county division fight into this campaign, and it now seems more than likely that the legislative contest may be fought out along that line, though such a contest is not a necessity at this time. According to the programme, Mr. Rothchild, the Democratic nominee, is to be slaughtered, and there will be a concentrated effort to elect Mr. Haworth, the Republican nominee, by those opposed to county-division. This throws the fight between Mr. Haworth and Mr. Holmes."

Mr. Holmes was in the Elgin section campaigning the past three days and found the anti-division sentiment so strong that he comes out in a statement that he does not favor county division. Well if he does not stand for division, what does he

This town cannot afford to go on record as being clannish for La Grande candidates, when their vital interests are not affected, as is the case with the sheriff's office. This city wants to go on record that outside candidate can expect their party vote in this city on either ticket. Now is the time to establish the precedent.

There will undoubtedly be considerable building in La Grande this summer and fall if we are alive to our possibilities.
