Every kind of cheap seed is either low in vitality, light in weight or adulterated. Poor seed causes a greater loss than keeping poor stock. It's cheaper to hand pick the seed before sowing than to rick the weeds after the crop is up. Better go a long distance to get good seed than take chances. With the rush of spring work the importance of sowing only the best seed is overlooked, but nothing will add so much to the year's profits as the careful seclection of the seed you plant.
