THE CURSE OF POOR SEED

Is not alone in the fact that it is less productive than good seed, but that bad weeds are likely to be introduced which will do more injury to the farm than the crop was worth. Every kind of cheap seed is either low in vitality, light in weight or adulterated. Poor seed causes a greater loss than keeping poor stock. It's cheaper to hand pick the seed before sowing than to pick the weeds after the crop is up. Better go a long distance to get good seed than take chances. With the rush of spring work the importance of sowing only the best seed is overlooked, but nothing will add so much to the year's profits as the careful selection of the seed you plant.
