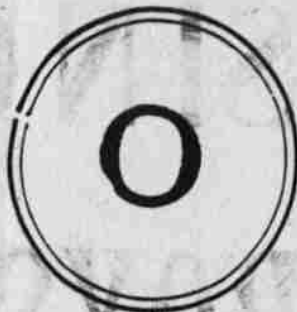
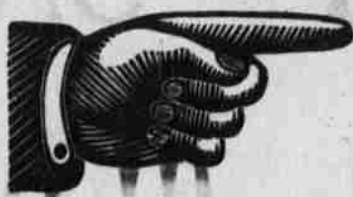

There is also an interesting collection of wild animals. An Eskimo family living in a hut of imitation ice and snow, a Japanese tea house inhabited by a Japanese family, and an Indian Museum, which contains many rare and interesting curios gathered from various Indian tribes which inhabited Michigan.

ORDINANCE NO. 326

Series 1906.

An ordinance directing and authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of La Grande, Oregon, to enter a contract with J. L. Mars for the construction of two cement cross walks for the city of La Grande, Oregon.

The city of La Grande does ordain as follows:

Section One:—That the Mayor and Recorder of the city of La Grande, Oregon be and they are hereby directed and authorized to enter into a written contract on behalf of the city of La Grande with J. L. Mars, for the construction of two cement cross walks at the intersection of Depot St. and Adams Ave. in accordance with the bid for construction and proposition of said J. L. Mars to construct said cement walks for the sum of \$124, each in city warrants drawn upon the general fund of the Treasurer of the said city of La Grande, and which bid and proposition for construction was accepted by the common council of the city of La Grande, Oregon, at a regular meeting held May 2, 1906.

Section Two:—That this ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from and after the 7th day of June 1906 and shall be published in one issue of the La Grande Observer.

Passed by the common council of the city of La Grande, Oregon, this 6th day of June 1906, by 7 councilmen voting therefor.

Approved by the Mayor this 7th day of June 1906.
