

The counties which went Republican from top to bottom on local offices were Columbia Crock, Jackson, Lake, Marion, Multnomah Sherman, Tillamook, Wasco, Washington and Wheeler. In Multnomah however the office of Sheriff is still in doubt, owning to the recount which is in progress.

The counties from which full returns are not at hand are Curry. Klamath, Lincoln, Malheur and Wallowa, In the other 17 counties the Democrats succeeded n landing one or more of their candidates for county offices.

Only in Baker was practically the entire Democratic county ticket elected. This was to expected as that county is a Democratic stronghold in Oregon, as is should by the fact that it helped swell Chambeslain's majority by nearly 700 votes, and also gave Gearin a lead ove Bourne.
