CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION

Munnsville, N. Y., June 25.—In honor of the one hundredth anniversary of the founding of the Town of Stockbridge a big celebration and reunion of former residents of the town is held here today. Elaborate preparations have been made for the event and it has attracted hundreds of visitors from the surrounding districts.

NOT MANY DEMOCRATS

In 11 Oregon counties out of 28 from which complete official election returns have received not a single Democratic candidate was successful in securing a county office at the polls this month. The counties which went Republican from top to bottom on local offices were Columbia, Crook, Jackson, Lake, Marion, Multnomah, Sherman, Tillamook, Wasco, Washington and Wheeler. In Multnomah however the office of Sheriff is still in doubt, owing to the recount which is in progress.

The counties from which full returns are not at hand are Curry, Klamath, Lincoln, Malheur and Willowa. In the other 17 counties the Democrats succeeded in landing one or more of their candidates for county offices.

Only in Baker was practically the entire Democratic county ticket elected. This was to be expected as that county is a Democratic stronghold in Oregon, as is shown by the fact that it helped swell Chamberlain's majority by nearly 700 votes, and also gave Gearin a lead over Bourne. In only six counties did the Democrats elect as many as three officers, while in five counties the party got only one office.

One peculiarity of the election is that it has resulted in giving Oregon 13 Democratic Sheriffs.

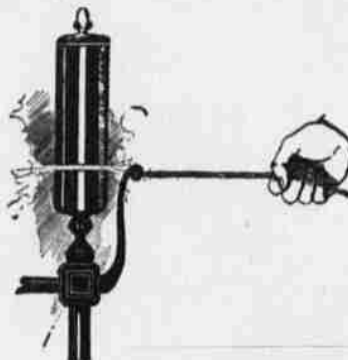
