They were married in England June 30, 1852, came to the United States in 1857, to Oregon in 1860 and were the first man and woman to make the first actual residence in Grande Ronde valley, settling and building the first house in what is now the city of La Grande in the fall of 1831. They have made their home as residence in this county from that time since, holding during all of these years the respect of an extensive acquaintance. Mr. Brown has been honored time and again with positions of public trust and on next Monday will enter upon a four year's service as county commissioner to which position he was elected at the last election. Mrs. Brown is 80 years, Mr. Brown 75. Their many friends wish them many more pleasant anniversaries.
