## RURAL MAIL BOXES

(Scripps News Association) Washington, D. C., August 1.—Today the order of Postmaster General Cortelyou goes into effect resinding the regulation under which patrons of rural mail routes are compelled to purchase boxes from one of the 200 listed manufacturers, who have put on the market 300 different styles of boxes, approved by the department. Patrons of rural routes will her after be permitted to make their own boxes, but they must be approved by the postmaster of their district and marked.
