after the best of our neighboring cities. This question has been under consideration by the city authorities for two years past and the old charter with the amendments enacted in 1905 has been written on the typewriter to prepare for publication. No attempt has been made to revise the ordinance and none is apt to be made unless the council employs experts to do the work properly. If the objections I have stated against

the vid charter are well founded t asked. "Is kitty hurt?" After being aswill be waste of time and money to publish this old charter but the matter should be deferred until the new charter is enacted by a vote of the people.

I will briefly enumerate the essentia features that the new charter should contain that are not already in the present charter.

The corporate powers, the boundaries of wards, the council representation. the of the city of La Grande at his office on city limits, the vested power and authority, and the titles and number of city day of August, 1006. officers to remain about the same.

The terms of all officers to be two years. whether elected or appointed, unless removed from office for cause. The officers to be elected are the mayor

and treasurer and members of the council. La Grande reserves the right to reject all other officers to be appointed by the mayor and confirmed by council, the mayor to have the power of removal for cause.

The qualifications for office and voters he same as now. Election laws the same.

The mayor to appoint all committees. The power to improve streets and build sewers to be made more extensive so that work may be commenced without so much delay.

With the conflicting sections corrected. the obsolete parts cut out, the repetitions removed and the omissions added that have been in this letter enumerated, and with the powers of the council embodied under one heading, and with the changes suggested as to term of office and the appointment and removal of officers, the balance of the new charter to be about the same as the old.




