From now on the O. R. & N. will employ only Japanese, Greeks and Italians to do the labor on the branch extention from Elgin to Joseph. The officials are adopting this plan for the reason that it is estimated that 5000 white laborers have secured transportation from their various homes to the scene of construction and when they get there they suddenly disappear and the company is still without laborers. Over half of the laborers who have secured passes from Spokane and other Northern points have dropped off at Walla Walla, Pendleton and this city. When they arrived here they spend their time in the saloon vicinity and talk of going to work for the farmers, but

when approached by a farmer who is in need of help they almost invariably refuse.

When the occasional car load of white laborers arrive in this city they have a habit of rapping an old blanket and sending it on to the destination at Wallowa thus giving the officials the impression of good faith.

This game has been played so long that the white man has been tabooed and the "Dago" will take his place.




