ELECTION AT ZION CITY

Zion City, Ill., September 18.—In accordance with an order issued by Judge K. M. Landis, of the United States District Court an election is being held here today for the selection of a new overseer who shall act as trustee of the property of the church which is variously estimated at between \$12,000,000, and \$21,000,000. The court has recently decided that neither John Alexander Dowie nor Wilbur Glenn, the present overseer of the Christian Catholic Church in Zion is the owner of the extensive church property but that they merely held the property in trust and were accountable to the members of the church. Volvia has many followers but is considered doubtful that he will be elected for the position. There are several candidates and it is believed that the vote will be split up among the various candidates.
